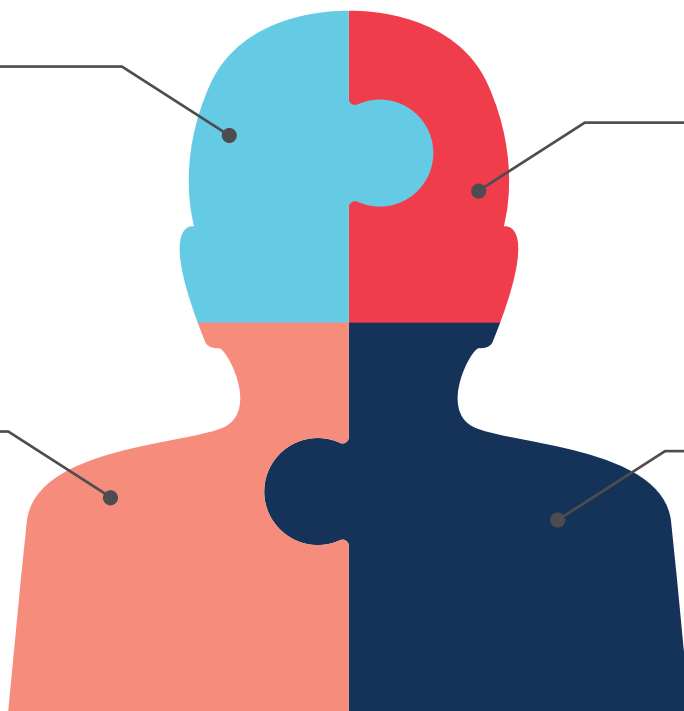

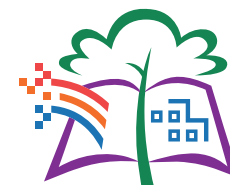

Wall Street English (WSE) Certificate in English Language Communication is qualified for the Continuing Education Fund (CEF)*. Eligible applicants will be reimbursed a maximum sum of HK\$25,000#, upon successful completion of a reimbursable course and passing a specified benchmark test provided by Wall Street English.

Reimbursable Amount

The enhancement measures were implemented from 1 Aug 2022. The ratio for the first \$10,000 subsidy is 80% of the course fee and that for the second \$15,000 subsidy is 60% of the course fee. Eligible applicants can apply for reimbursement up to \$25,000.

Number of Claims

Applicants aged 18 or above can submit an unlimited number of reimbursement claims for a total subsidy up to \$25,000.

Eligible of a reimbursement

Students are required to have an attendance record of 70% or above, achieving the total score of 70% or above in 5 Level Checkpoints across two assessments, achieving a designated or higher score on a specified Versant benchmark test. The cost of the Versant test is \$780.
